THE BEST TIME TO VISIT

Bourbon Cataratas is surrounded by lush, tropical gardens. It offers a variety of activities that can be enjoyed by all, including 2 swimming pools, a tennis court, and Kids Club. For relaxation there is a day-spa with massage services and sauna at an extra charge.

DAY-BY-DAY

Upon arrival at the airport, you will be met by a representative and transferred to your hotel. The remainder of your day is for you to explore the historic neighborhoods and enjoy the cafe culture of Buenos Aires.

Visit iconic sites such as La Boca, San Telmo, Puerto Madero, Plaza de Mayo, 9th of July Avenue, the Colón Theatre, and the Recoleta Cemetery, known for its impressive sculptures and artwork.

This tour offers a panoramic walk to explore the geological formation of the Iguazu Falls and connect with nature. Starting early in the morning increases the chances of spotting unique species of birds, butterflies, mammals, flowers, and plants. With three different itineraries, the tour is designed to awaken the senses towards the natural environment and create a harmonious connection between humans and nature.

The National Park of do Iguacu in Brazil was declared World Natural Heritage by the UNESCO in 1986, after such nomination of the Iguazu National Park in Argentina. Visiting this area consists of the only circuit of walkways that are placed in front of the Falls, offering a truly impressive panoramic view. The circuit is 1200 meters long and composed of stairs. Unfortunately, for this reason it's impossible to use a wheelchair. At the end of the circuit there is an elevator. The stairs contain 130 steps and are 220 meters long.

Later in the afternoon, transfer to the Airport. Flight from Iguazu to Buenos Aires (not included)

TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Argentina currently requires all foreign nationals entering the country to have a negative PCR COVID-19 test taken within 72 hours prior to their arrival. Additionally, travelers must complete an online health declaration form and have proof of health insurance that covers COVID-19. Requirements may change and it's always recommended to check the latest entry requirements with the Argentine embassy.

CURRENCY

The currency of Argentina is the Argentine peso (ARS). It is subdivided into 100 centavos and is denoted with the symbol "\$" or sometimes "AR\$". The exchange rate of the Argentine peso can be volatile and subject to fluctuations, so it is advisable to keep up to date with current exchange rates before exchanging or using currency.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

Argentina is generally a safe country for travelers, but like any other major city, there are certain areas of Buenos Aires that should be avoided, especially at night. As for health, it is recommended to drink bottled water and be cautious with street food to avoid stomach issues.

LANGUAGE

The official language of Argentina is Spanish, which is spoken by the vast majority of the population. There are also other languages spoken in certain regions such as Italian, German, and Guarani.

CULTURE

Argentine culture is a mix of European, indigenous, and African influences. It is known for its tango music and dance, as well as its love for soccer, beef, and wine.
